

HOW TO PHOTOGRAPH YOUR ROOM

1. HOLD YOUR CAMERA SIDEWAYS TO GET WIDE PHOTOS.
2. THE FIRST PHOTO SHOULD BE LOOKING INTO THE ROOM FROM THE HALLWAY OR ADJACENT ROOM.
3. NOW GO STAND IN A CORNER OF THE ROOM (OR AS FAR AS YOU CAN GET).
4. TAKE A PHOTO OF THE ENTIRE WALL (OR AS MUCH AS YOU CAN) ON THE LEFT SIDE.
5. NOW TAKE A PHOTO OF THE ENTIRE WALL ON THE RIGHT SIDE.
6. REPEAT THIS WITH EACH CORNER OF THE ROOM...YOU SHOULD HAVE 9 PHOTOS IN TOTAL.
